- No exterior window cleaning or work done above ground level
- No construction or criminal site clean up
- No hazardous material or biohazard clean up
- No mold remediation
- No gutter or chimney cleaning

General Exclusions: No Aircraft exposure; No Mid-term business, unless they are coming out for PEO or Captive; No business with less than 3 years of prior workers comp coverage, may consider Parcel with more than 2 years of prior workers comp coverage; No 1099 Exposure greater than 40%; No risks coming out of a PEO, unless they have their own NCCI or state bureau ex-mod; No Staffing Agencies; No USL&H; No Jones Act; No Maritime Employers Liability; No Foreign Coverage; No Retroactive policies; No Large risk alternative rating option (LRAR).
